Simple Eulogy Structure

Part	What to Say
Opening	Welcome everyone and introduce your relationship with the person.
Memory	Share one meaningful story or moment.
Personality	Describe the qualities, habits, and values that made them special.
Impact	Explain how they influenced your life or the lives of others.
Closing	End with gratitude, love, remembrance, or a final farewell.
